MEMORY This is the number of pictures that can be stored on a reusable card in the camera at one time. Look for a card with at least 64 megabytes of memory enough to store about 350 pictures.

OPTICAL ZOOM Magnifies the subject to get shots that appear close-up. Avoid cameras with digital or electronic zoom, a gimmicky feature that makes a subject look closer but doesn't improve resolution, leading to fuzzy pics. If you mainly take group shots of people, you'll need less zoom (1x or 4x); if you're taking faraway shots, you'll need more (10x or 12x).
